### DAY 1 – ACCESS YOUR HEAVENLY GRANT

When you pray, ask the Father in Jesus' Name and He will give it to you.

#### STUDY IT

- The Scripture says that the Father will *grant* you whatever you ask in Jesus' Name (John 16:23).
  - The scripture also says that whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that it is *granted* to you, and you will have it (Mark 11:24 AMP).
  - The words, “but, what if” are the badge of unbelief.
  - Refuse to say anything else except: “It is granted.”
- Whenever God tells you to give something or do something, be quick to obey (Luke 6:38).
- To get your needs met, pray for wisdom (James 1:5-6).
- Pray in your native language and pray in the spirit (1 Corinthians 14:15).
- The Lord will speak to you, and what He says will be in line with God's Word.
- God doesn't answer your prayer because you need something—He answers because He loves you!

#### MAKE IT PERSONAL

## DAY 2 – HOW TO GROW IN FAITH

We are studying “mountain-moving faith.” Jesus was talking about spiritual mountains that become physical problems.

### STUDY IT

- Jesus spoke to a fig tree, because it had no fruit.
  - The disciples saw that His words affected the life of the tree.
- At the time of the new birth, the faith of God is imparted into the spirit of every born-again child of God.
- We are born again of the incorruptible seed, the Word of God (1 Peter 1:23).
  - When your spirit is born again:
    - You have the same body, but you are told to sacrifice it.
    - You have the same mind, but you are told to renew it (Romans 12:1-3).
- When you have revelation that the Bible is a manifestation of God in this earth, you will never be a failure again.
- Faith comes and your spirit is strengthened by hearing the Word of God (Romans 10:17).

### DAY 3 – HOW FAITH IS RELEASED

Your words are strong in your life because you speak God's words. Choose your words so you stay in agreement with whatever God's Word says (Psalm 19:14).

### STUDY IT

- Patience, not faith, comes from testings and trials (James 1:2-4).
- When you stand in faith, you stop the trial from affecting you, and can count it all joy.
- You are not fighting the devil or his works, you are fighting the good fight of faith (1 Timothy 6:12).
  - The devil is fighting you to steal the Word of God (Mark 4:14),
  - When the devil attacks, laugh at him, because he is already defeated (Nehemiah 8:10).
- Believe that God wants to answer your prayers and give you what you need (John 14:13).
- Fill your eyes, ears and heart with God's Word, and faith will come (Proverbs 4:20-24).
- If all you talk about is death, that's what you'll have—if all you talk about is life, that's what you'll have (Proverbs 18:21).

### DAY 4 – SAY IT BY FAITH

It is so important to discipline your mouth to speak words that are obedient to God's Word. His Word in your heart will tame and control the tongue.

### STUDY IT

- God gives power to the fainthearted (Isaiah 40:28-31).
  - Say continually, "I am strong, I run without weariness, I walk and don't faint."
  - Hope, expect, and trust in God to make you strong.
- Say things that are not yet, as though they already were (Romans 4:17).
  - Discipline yourself to speak God's Word, even if your situation and feelings are contrary to what you're speaking.
- First of all, seek God and His righteousness (Matthew 6:33).
- By faith, lay hold on every blessing the Lord has promised.
- Putting God's Word into your mouth is like handing God the reins to your life.
- Turning your life to God's way of doing things takes diligence, commitment, prayer and quality time in God's Word.

### DAY 5 – MOUNTAIN-MOVING FAITH

Faith must be released and applied to every situation. Unless faith is called upon, it lies dormant in your born-again spirit. Faith must be believed in the heart, then spoken with words and followed up with action—all the while rejecting fear and doubt.

### STUDY IT

- When you put a demand on faith, you must continue to believe and speak—that's called patience (James 1:3-4).
- The lady with the issue of blood *believed* Jesus could heal, she *said* she would be healed if she touched His garment, then she *touched* His prayer shawl (Mark 5:22-34).
  - Jesus said her faith had made her whole.
  - She believed, the miracle of healing came, *then* she felt in her body—she believed and *then* it took place.
  - Jesus' power and Anointing healed her, but His power was not initiated until she put action to her belief and words by touching His clothes.
- You believe God's Word in your heart, you say it with your mouth and then you do it!
- God needs your faith before His power can do anything.
- God's Word cannot fail when it is believed, spoken and acted upon.
