

WHAT IS REVELATION KNOWLEDGE?

DAY 1 – THE ROCK OF REVELATION KNOWLEDGE

Everything found in the Bible is part of two covenants; old covenant and new covenant. The change of names in covenant is extremely important. God is a Spirit. They who worship Him, must worship Him in spirit and in truth. Lucifer, a beautiful angel, fell and became satan, the devil. The very God of peace will sanctify you wholly.

STUDY IT

- I. Everything found in the Bible is part of two covenants—the old covenant and new covenant.
 - In covenant, God gives us everything He has; and we give Him everything we have.

- II. The change of names in covenant is extremely important.
 - We see the name change in our modern marriage covenant. The lady takes her new husband's name.
 - When Gloria Jean Neece and Kenneth Copeland married, she became Gloria Jean Copeland.
 - She took Brother Copeland's name, and everything he owned now belonged to her.
 - When God changed Abram's name to Abraham, He put His Name in the middle of Abram. That's part of entering into covenant.
 - Jesus asked His disciples, "Whom do men say that I am?" (Matthew 16:13).
 - Simon's declaration that Jesus was the Son of God caused Jesus to change his name to Peter (*Peter* from the Greek word *petros* meaning a *rock* or a *stone*).
 - Jesus said, "BLESSED are you, Simon son of Jonah. Your name is now Peter, and on this rock shall I build My Church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it" (see Matthew 16:17-18).
 - Jesus didn't build His Church on Peter. He built the Church on Himself and on revelation knowledge (Matthew 16:18).
 - Revelation knowledge is knowledge revealed to your spirit being.
 - Sense knowledge is based on the five physical senses. That's how children learn. They grow up believing what their senses report.



- III. God is a Spirit. "They who worship Him, must worship Him in spirit and in truth" (John 4:23-24).
- What is truth? Jesus said, "Thy WORD is truth" (John 17:17). Continue in My WORD (see John 8:31).
 - Jesus' words are spirit and life. "And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free" (John 8:32).
 - Facts are not necessarily truth.
 - The truth that healing belongs to you will make you free from sickness and disease.
 - Apply the truth that Jesus has promised you healing.
 - Then apply the fact (it has already happened), "by Jesus' stripes you were healed" (1 Peter 2:24), and it makes you free. It will get rid of any problem in your body.
- IV. Lucifer, a beautiful angel, fell and became satan, the devil.
- The devil is a spirit being; he is not flesh and blood.
 - He was perfect in the day he was created but iniquity was found in him (Ezekiel 28:15).
 - His iniquity was the lie he gave birth to. He's a liar and the father of it.
- V. The very God of peace sanctify you wholly (1 Thessalonians 5:23).
- *Peace* means *shalom* which means "prosperity, soundness and healing: nothing missing and nothing broken."
 - "I pray God your whole spirit, soul and body..." in that order—not body, mind and spirit and not body and soul.
 - Faithful is He who calls you, who will do it (1 Thessalonians 5:24).
 - "He will...accomplish it."
 - The spirit and soul are not the same thing.
 - The *Chumash*, the Jewish commentary of the first five books of the Bible, says that man became a living, speaking spirit like God (see Genesis 2:7).

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Pray with us:

Heavenly Father, I ask You in Jesus' Name to give me revelation knowledge of You and Your WORD. I depend on You to speak into my spirit the mysteries, the understanding and the wisdom You have prepared for me. Thank You, Sir. In Jesus' Name I pray. Amen.



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DAY 2 – KNOWLEDGE REVEALED BY THE SPIRIT OF GOD

Revelation knowledge is when revelation comes into your spirit and suddenly you know something you didn't know before. When Brother Copeland received revelation about the word *Christ*, he went back to the Bible and found each place the word *Christ* is used. You are a spirit, you have a soul and you live in a body. The outward man, the flesh, is dying, but the inward man can be renewed day by day. We can be very bold, especially toward the devil.

STUDY IT

- I. Revelation knowledge is when revelation comes into your spirit and suddenly you know something you didn't know before.
 - The power of God is in the Name of Jesus. We are to use the Name of Jesus.
 - For example: Brother Copeland knew that *Christ* is not Jesus' last name when it was revealed to him from the Holy Spirit—revealed, not learned.
 - *Christ* is not even a title. The word *Christ* is from the Greek meaning “anointing.”

- II. When Brother Copeland received revelation about the word *Christ*, he went back to the Bible and found the places the word *Christ* is used.
 - Each time, he asked three questions:
 - Is this usage speaking of Jesus Himself?
 - Is it speaking of the anointing? Or both Jesus and the Anointing?
 - Is it speaking about us?
 - We believers are “anointed.”
 - At the beginning of the Church, believers were called “followers of Christ.”
 - All they preached was the anointing—the Anointing on Jesus Christ (Acts 10:28).
 - Believers first began to be called Christians, or “little Christs” or “little anointed ones” because they preached what Jesus preached—the anointing.
 - “The Spirit of The LORD has anointed Me” (Luke 4:18).
 - We are named after Jesus Christ, the Anointed.
 - We are Christ-ians. We are anointed.



- The more you find out about this, the more the devil attacks you.
 - The more you are attacked, the more victory you have over the devil.
- III. You are a spirit; you have a soul (mind, will, emotions); and you live in a body (see 1 Thessalonians 5:23).
- This truth is reinforced all through God's WORD.
 - "If the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead, lives in you, He will quicken [make alive] your mortal body" (Romans 8:11).
 - "Know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost?" (1 Corinthians 6:19).
 - You live in your body. The Holy Spirit lives in your spirit.
 - Others can't see the real you. They can only see your earth suit.
 - When you leave this earth and go to heaven, your spirit and soul go. The body remains here in the earth until the resurrection.
 - When you get to heaven, you'll still be you. You'll be able to recognize others you knew in the earth.
- IV. The outward man, the flesh, is dying, but the inward man can be renewed day by day (see 2 Corinthians 4:16).
- Your spirit and soul don't have to get older. Renew your youth (Psalm 103:5).
 - Your body is getting older; it's dying a little every day.
 - By The WORD of God and faith, you can stop or slow physical dying according to Romans 8:11.
 - Brother Copeland has a covenant with God. Part of the covenant is to live in his physical body for 120 years. See the footnotes in Genesis 6:3, *AMPC*.
 - The purpose for Brother Copeland to live to 120 is to preach and teach the Word of Faith. This became a revelation to him.
- V. We can be very bold, especially toward the devil (Ephesians 3:10-12).
- The Father will strengthen and renew your inner man.
 - "I bow to the Father that He would grant you to be strengthened in your inner man" (see Ephesians 3:14-16).
 - The Father will cause you to comprehend—have a working knowledge (Ephesians 3:18).
 - The Father is offering you to be filled with the knowledge of God according to the power (*dumanis*) that works in you (Ephesians 3:19-20).
 - God highly exalted Jesus and seated Him in the heavenly place. We are seated there beside Him.
 - Even now on earth, we can be attentive to things in heaven, rather than things in the earth.



MAKE IT PERSONAL

Have you ever been reading the Bible or listening to a sermon, and suddenly something “jumps out at you”? It’s a new thought, a new understanding. It’s a revelation, or revealed knowledge from the Holy Spirit of God. He speaks to your spirit, and His words illuminate your mind.

Ask the Holy Spirit to give you revelation on the following scripture. Read it several times and take time to meditate on it. Write down any new revelation you receive.

“What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?” (1 Corinthians 6:19).





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DAY 3 – PUTTING SPIRIT, SOUL AND BODY IN THE RIGHT ORDER

There is a specific order: spirit, soul and body. Put first things first. God's WORD will judge. Man was created to be a speaking spirit like God. Jesus was a born-again, Holy Spirit-baptized man.

STUDY IT

- I. There is a specific order: spirit, soul and body.
 - “And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ” (1 Thessalonians 5:23).
 - We are separating the spirit, the soul and the body for study purposes; yet it's vitally important that the spirit always be put first.
 - Your spirit is the part of you that is in contact with the Holy Spirit of God.

- II. Put first things first.
 - First is the spirit, then the soul made up of your mind, your will and your emotions. In other words, the intellectual part of a human being.
 - The body is self-explanatory.
 - “The WORD of God is quick....” *Quick* has an old-fashioned word meaning “alive, living”—The WORD of God is alive (Hebrews 4:12).
 - The WORD of God is life itself. “In the beginning was The WORD, and The WORD was with God and The WORD was God” (John 1:1).
 - The WORD is powerful and sharper than any two-edged sword (Hebrews 4:12).
 - Paul uses the sword as an analogy of The WORD of God.
 - The WORD divides the soul and spirit and joints and marrow. It is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. Neither is there any creature that is not manifest in His sight (Hebrews 4:12-13).
 - The *Weymouth New Testament* translation reads: “For The WORD of God is full of life and power, and is keener than the sharpest two-edged sword. It pierces even to the severance of soul from spirit” (Hebrews 4:12).





- III. The WORD will judge. We are not to judge, except to judge ourselves (1 Corinthians 11:31).
- Don't judge anyone, especially political leaders. Their place in the government exposes them to attacks by high-ranking demons.
 - The devil wants to wipe out this nation because we preach the gospel throughout the world.
 - Even before there was a George Washington, the Founders of this country pledged to follow and worship God.
 - This nation cannot be destroyed by the devil. We believers come down on him and cause damage to his kingdom.
- IV. Man was created a speaking spirit like God (Genesis 2:7, *Chumash*).
- Man is the only creation that can choose words and speak them.
 - Words are first and foremost for the release of power, then communication.
 - Make this declaration: I am a spirit. I have a soul made up of my mind, will and emotions. I live in a body.
 - You are a spirit. God is in your spirit; therefore, God is in your body.
 - "I beseech you, therefore, brethren, that you present your body..." (Romans 12:1).
 - Where your body, mind, will and emotions are concerned, you are the boss.
 - Jesus said, "Why take ye thought, saying..." (Matthew 6:31).
 - Don't say what you are thinking.
- V. Jesus was a born-again, Holy Spirit-baptized man.
- He was manifested in the flesh. God was His Father; Mary was His mother.
 - Jesus went to hell and suffered more than any person. He was made a curse for us and then made alive in the Spirit.
 - Jesus was the firstborn from the dead. We, through Jesus, have first-born status, first born BLESSING in Jesus.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Make this declaration:

My mind is my mind. The devil can't make me think anything. I cast his thoughts down from my mind. I refused to be moved by what I feel or by what I see. I am only moved by what I believe, and I believe The WORD of God. I believe this covenant. I have a covenant relationship with The LORD Jesus Christ of Nazareth.



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DAY 4 – WHAT IS SENSE KNOWLEDGE?

Sense knowledge is knowledge gained through the five physical senses. Renew your mind to prove the acceptable will of God for your life. Progressive knowledge gained through books and other devices will increase your personal natural knowledge. As a child during WWII, Brother Copeland fell in love with this country and its flag.

STUDY IT

- I. Sense knowledge is knowledge gained through the five physical senses.
 - Sense knowledge learning is based on building a foundation.
 - Your knowledge learned from textbooks grew on the foundation of previous information.
 - Brother Copeland had trouble understanding algebra.
 - The LORD suggested that he pray in the spirit for help with studying.
 - Sure enough, his comprehension and ability to focus during study time began to increase.
 - The Spirit helped him learn, but he started with sense knowledge.

- II. Renew your mind to prove the acceptable will of God for your life (see Romans 12:2).
 - God has a specific purpose for your life. Find it and stay with it.
 - Don't fall for that lie that says you can choose to be whatever you want to be.
 - Be what God called you to be.
 - Every born-again believer can hear the voice of The LORD in his/her born-again spirit—if he/she listens.

- III. Progressive knowledge gained through books and other devices will increase your personal natural knowledge.
 - However, be cautious about where and from whom you learn.
 - Brother Copeland went with a friend to visit a professor who taught at a Christian university.
 - The friend inquired about another professor who was an atheist.



- The man said, “Yes, the professor in question still teaches here. He may be an atheist, but he knows the Bible.”
 - You can't know the Bible if you don't know God. You can only know the words in the Bible.
- IV. As a child during WWII, Brother Copeland fell in love with this country and its flag.
- The class learned to recite the Pledge of Allegiance each day using sense knowledge.
 - One day, Brother Copeland got a revelation of what the flag was and what it stood for.
 - His love and appreciation for the United States is still a major part of his life.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Pray with us:

Heavenly Father, I ask that by revelation You increase me in wisdom, knowledge and understanding. Teach me Your WORD. Teach me Your thoughts and Your ways. I want to learn of You. I open my spirit to be taught by Your Holy Spirit. Thank You that Your revelations will fill me and guide me. In Jesus' Name. Amen.





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DAY 5 – HOW TO RECEIVE REVELATION KNOWLEDGE

You receive revelation knowledge into your spirit. Brother Copeland read 1 John every day and revelation knowledge began to build in him. God is the Greater One! Refuse to fear! The book of 1 John is a love book and a faith book.

STUDY IT

- I. You receive revelation knowledge into your spirit.
 - Jesus taught about a *certain* rich man and a beggar, Lazarus. This was not a parable.
 - Both men died.
 - The rich man looked up, saw Abraham and knew who he was. In his lifetime, he had never seen Abraham but the man's spirit recognized him.
 - The rich man in torment was a spirit being. His body, including his brain, was dead and buried in the earth.
 - Abraham said, "Son, remember...." Even though his body was dead, his spirit and soul were still intact, and he could remember what happened in his lifetime.
 - His character was unchanged. He's still trying to boss Lazarus around. He told Abraham, "Tell Lazarus to bring me water."
 - Your mind uses your brain. Your brain is part of your body.

- II. Brother Copeland read 1 John every day and revelation knowledge began to build in him.
 - He taught on the love of God from 1 John for about two years. Then 9/11 happened.
 - The LORD said, *I want you to strip the fear from the Body of Christ. Launch a war against fear.*
 - Brother Copeland preached, "Perfect love casts out fear," and people began to listen (1 John 4:18).
 - We are taught to pray in the spirit to receive from God (1 Corinthians 12, 14).
 - Whatsoever you desire, you will receive... (Mark 11:24). Revelation came! You can receive even when you are praying in the spirit!





- Brother Copeland prays in the spirit for his Partners so they can receive whatever they need wherever they are.
 - He receives the answer by faith even though he's praying in the spirit.

- III. God is the Greater One!
 - He's your Comforter, Teacher, Advocate, Standby and Strengthener; He's with you forever.
 - That knowledge came by revelation.
 - I am not just filled—I am full with the Greater One. Greater is He that's within me, than he that's in the world (1 John 4:4).
 - Believe God loves you and have faith in God's love for you (1 John 4:16).
 - The disciples said "LORD, don't You care?" (Mark 4:38).
 - God didn't let trouble come on you. *You* let that come on you.
 - Gloria said: "Depression is grieving when you haven't lost anything. Depression is just thinking about yourself all the time, and that's enough to depress anyone."

- IV. Refuse to fear!
 - Fear is from the devil. If fear is there, torment is there also.
 - God loves this nation, and He's not done with it, so don't fear.
 - As a girl, Lyndsey was diagnosed with meningitis. Her mother, Kellie Copeland, told her sister, Pastor Terri, "I refuse to fear."
 - He who fears is not mature in love (1 John 4:18).
 - "By this we know..." meaning it has been revealed to us (1 John 5:2).

- V. This is the victory that overcomes the world, even our faith (1 John 5:4).
 - The LORD told Brother Copeland to preach and teach victory: victory in the new birth; victory in the baptism in the Holy Spirit; victory over sickness; victory in righteousness; and more.
 - Brother Copeland began on the radio. The program was called *The Victory Broadcast*.
 - Later, he moved to television. That program is *Believer's Voice of Victory*.
 - Now, he has the VICTORY Channel®.
 - Do you believe Jesus is the Son of God? Then you are a world overcomer.

- VI. The book of 1 John is a love book and a faith book.
 - "These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God. And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: And if we know that he hears us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him" (1 John 5:13-15).





- Let your faith expand as you mediate on these scriptures.
- You have authority as a believer to bind and loose. Go in Jesus' Name and preach the good news.
- Jesus has authority in the earth through His Body. He's the head—the authority is in us.
