

THE GOODNESS OF GOD IS HERE TO HEAL

DAY 1 – INVEST TIME IN GOD'S WORD TO RECEIVE HEALING

Jesus is the Healer. Invest time, take your medicine (God's WORD), and believe God's WORD for your healing. If we hear and do what God says, faith comes, and faith works every time.

STUDY IT

- I. Jesus is the Healer.
 - The Bible is our healing school textbook.
 - “My son, forget not my law or teaching, but let your heart keep my commandments; for length of days and years of a life [worth living] and tranquility [inward and outward and continuing through old age till death], these shall they add to you” (Proverbs 3:1-2, *AMPC*).
 - Keeping God's commandments as a duty without keeping them in your heart doesn't bring results.

- II. Invest time in God's WORD to receive healing.
 - A life without a relationship with Jesus isn't worth living.
 - The remedy: Spend time in The WORD with The LORD, praising and worshipping Him.
 - Teach these things to your children.
 - To have a life worth living, get up early and read The WORD. You have time if you take the time.

- III. Take your medicine (God's WORD) for healing.
 - “My son, attend to my words; consent and submit to my sayings. Let them not depart from your sight; keep them in the center of your heart. For they are life to those who find them, healing and health to all their flesh” (Proverbs 4:20-22, *AMPC*).
 - *Healing* can be translated *medicine*.
 - Give The WORD first priority.
 - Incline (turn) your eyes and ears to God's WORD.



- Put your eyes on the Scripture. Look at it and read it, even if you have it memorized.
 - Write out several healing scriptures, and tape the paper to your mirror so you can read them as you get ready for the day.
- IV. If we hear and do what God says, faith comes, and faith works every time.
- When faith comes, fear retreats.
 - Faith and fear are both spiritual forces, yet they are opposite.
 - Faith and fear are like a compass. Faith is like north; fear is like south. They are exactly opposite of each other.
 - Faith receives from God.
 - Fear, worry and doubt are unbelief. They are fear-based, and they will kill you.
- V. Believe The WORD for your healing.
- Years ago, Brother Copeland had severe symptoms of the flu.
 - He read, "By His stripes you were healed" (I Peter 2:24).
 - He said out loud, "Father, I choose to believe this."
 - Unbelief would have said, "I just can't do this; I'm just too sick."
 - Immediately he began to feel better.
 - The next morning, he was up and healed from head to toe.
 - Brother Copeland chose to believe God's written WORD, and he was healed!

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Examine how you spend your time. We all need to sleep and eat, and some of us have commitments to an employer. It's the other hours of the day that need to be monitored. How much time do you give your family? What do you do with your free time? How much of your day belongs to The LORD for Bible study and prayer?

This kind of self-examination helps us prioritize our direction in life.

Let's pray together:

Heavenly Father, thank You for being my God and for bringing me into Your family through the blood of Jesus. I want to spend time with You, yet I find myself distracted with other things. My life should be Yours to guide.

Please help me rearrange my life to give You and Your WORD first place. Show me where I'm spending too much time on entertainment. Identify worries and fears that hinder our relationship. Help me change to be continually aware of You, to think Your thoughts, speak Your WORD and praise You. Thank You, Sir. In Jesus' Name. Amen.



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DAY 2 – REPENT OF SIN TO STAY WELL

To stay well, you must have the faith of God. The LORD promised to never leave you nor forsake you. When Brother Copeland attended Oral Roberts University, he learned about the prayer of agreement. The LORD spoke to Brother Copeland about his relationship with his son, John.

STUDY IT

- I. To stay well, you must have the faith of God.
 - Faith resides in your spirit—it's that spiritual force that came when you received Jesus as your LORD and Savior. It is a gift of God. It's the God kind of faith.
 - "Let brotherly love continue" (Hebrews 13:1).
 - Faith works by love (see Galatians 5:6), because God is Love (see 1 John 4:8).
 - You can choose to love or not love.
 - Love is not a feeling, it's a person. It's Jesus.
 - God sends angels to minister to His people.
 - Angels are healing agents (see Hebrews 1:14).
 - Some people have entertained angels without being aware of who they were (see Hebrews 13:2).
- II. The LORD promised to never leave you nor forsake you (see Hebrews 13:5).
 - When you sin, repent. He's forgotten your sins and trespasses, so you forget them too!
 - Take Communion over your healing and the forgiveness of sins.
 - Practice His presence and talk to Him—then listen. Tell Him how much you love Him!
- III. When Brother Copeland attended Oral Roberts University, he learned about the prayer of agreement.
 - He read Jesus' prayer and determined to agree with everything Jesus prayed (John 17).



- Brother Copeland learned that God loves him as much as He loves Jesus (see John 17:23)! This was a huge revelation to him!
- God loves Kenneth, and God loves you! Put your name there!
- God loves everything but sin. He even loves the sinner. That revelation of God's love will heal you!

- IV. The LORD spoke to Brother Copeland about his relationship with his son, John.
- The LORD said, *You magnify his sin. When he does something wrong, you get on him. You are only the father of his flesh.*
 - Brother Copeland repented, then reminded John that because he was born again, they were more than father and son—they were brothers in Christ Jesus, and friends.
 - Children, honor your parents and you'll live long on the earth (see Ephesians 6:2-3).
 - Jesus is full of compassion, slow to anger, abounding in mercy and loving-kindness. The LORD is good to all! (see Psalm 145:8-9).
 - The LORD will fulfill the desires of those who reverently and worshipfully fear Him—including healing.
 - He will also hear their cry and save them.
 - He's a good God. He loves you, and He wants you well.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Repentance is an attitude of the heart as well as spoken words. A soft heart will repent quickly from sin. A humble spirit will be aware of what pleases God and what does not, and will seek His ways.

Write a prayer of your own to pray when you know you have missed it. God has forgiven you; repent so your heart can be cleansed (see 1 John 1:9).



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DAY 3 – RECEIVERS GET HEALING

Receivers get healing. God is so good. He wants you well. Become a receiver. Jesus healed all who would receive it. Keep your focus on what God has for you today and don't waver.

STUDY IT

- I. Receivers get healing.
 - Jesus marveled at the faith of the centurion and said, "I have not found such faith, no, not in all of Israel" (Matthew 8:10).
 - Later, Peter preached to the centurion.
 - "How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him" (Acts 10:38).

- II. God is so good. He wants you well.
 - Jesus came and bore our sins in His own body on the tree.
 - That's not all. Jesus died, went through the torment of hell, and paid the price for our healing and redemption.
 - He bore stripes at the whipping post (see 1 Peter 2:24).
 - It's not salvation *or* healing; it's salvation *and* healing *and* deliverance *and* miracles. Jesus paid the price for it all! It's free! Receive it!
 - Believe that you receive it, and you shall have it.

- III. Become a receiver.
 - You have to *receive* healing and salvation.
 - You can't get born again without receiving Jesus.
 - You can't get born again without believing in your heart and saying it with your mouth (see Romans 10:9). That's faith.



- IV. Jesus healed all who would receive it. He's already done it. He's done the will of God.
- Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, so that THE BLESSING of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ (see Galatians 3:13-14).
 - Everyone, not just Jews, can receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.
 - We've been redeemed from every sickness, disease, flu, cancer, blind eye and deaf ear.
 - Our bones, ears, lungs and backs have all been redeemed—everything has!
 - There's no such thing as a new disease. It's all under the curse (see Deuteronomy 28:61).
 - COVID-19 and cancer are part of the curse of the law. They are names, and they have to bow to the Name of Jesus.
 - It's God who loves you and heals you!
 - Jesus is the same yesterday, today and forever (see Hebrews 13:8).
- V. Keep your focus on what God has for you today and don't waver.
- You are supposed to prosper and be in health today. You're supposed to be healed today.
 - You are supposed to have a life worth living.
 - You're supposed to live long on the earth.
 - It's appointed unto every man once to die, but you have something to do with the timing.
 - The way you conduct your life, what you say and believe in your heart, affect your spirit, soul and body.
 - You are responsible for the way you feed your spirit, mind and body.
 - God has provided the spirit food, the mind food and the physical food, but He won't feed you. That's your choice. That's your decision.
 - Decide today to receive Jesus as your LORD and Savior.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Make this declaration:

"I am a receiver! I study God's WORD, and I am aware of what He wants me to have. My part is to receive, and I'm a good receiver!

"I receive everything God has given me, now!"



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DAY 4 – THE GOOD NEWS OF HEALING

Our good God heals! Jesus healed a man on the Sabbath and shook everyone up at the synagogue. Jesus told His disciples that God was good. “The Anointed”—that’s what *Christ* means.

STUDY IT

- I. Our good God heals!
 - Great multitudes followed Him and He healed them (see Matthew 19:2).
 - All who touched Jesus were made whole.
 - The definition of *sozo* is: “made whole, saved, delivered, kept from destruction.” They were healed, made well and whole.
 - Teaching brings faith. We know that at some point, Jesus’ brothers understood.
 - James, Jesus’ half-brother, knew about the corresponding action of faith because he grew up with Jesus (see James 2:20). He saw his Big Brother use faith.
- II. Jesus healed a man on the Sabbath and shook everyone up at the synagogue.
 - Jesus laid hands on everyone who came to Him and healed them (see Luke 4:40).
 - Jesus said you ought to be healed (see Luke 13:16).
 - Wherever you are, you ought to be healed of that infirmity.
 - You should be loosed today. You are a child of God.
 - If you’re not, receive Jesus as your LORD and Savior; receive Him as your Healer.
- III. Jesus told His disciples that God was good.
 - God is not trying to curse you. He’s not holding your sins against you. You’re in His kingdom of goodness.
 - Jesus healed all those who had need of healing. Now that is good news!
- IV. “The Anointed”—that’s what *Christ* means (see Matthew 22:42).
 - Blind Bartimaeus sat along the road and heard that Jesus was coming (see Mark 10:46-52).
 - Bartimaeus shouted, “Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me.” He called Jesus the Messiah, the Anointed One.



- The LORD asked Bartimaeus, "What will you have Me do for you?"
- He said, "LORD, that I may receive my sight."
- Jesus said to him, "Go your way. Your faith has made you whole."
- Immediately he received his sight and followed Jesus, glorifying God.
- God was not glorified by the blindness, but the healing brought Him glory.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Good News! Read all about it!

That's what was published in newspapers and newspeople shouted it on the street corners of cities across the nation when war was over.

Our war with God is over! Our sins have been forgiven, forever! We are cleansed, we are healed and whole and we are in a personal relationship with our Savior, Jesus Christ. That's good news!

It's time for us to shout it! Tell your family, friends, neighbors and your co-workers. Good news! God is for us, who can be against us? (see Romans 8:31).



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DAY 5 – PLUG IN WITH FAITH FOR YOUR HEALING

Faith is real. Plug in with faith for your healing. Make an effort. It's time for *you* to be healed. Brother Copeland gave his testimony about his heart.

STUDY IT

- I. Faith is real.
 - If faith in your life is lying dormant, then stir it up!
 - Paul wrote to Timothy to “stir yourself up” (2 Timothy 1:6).
 - This is how you stay healed and well.
 - Abstain from all appearance of evil (1 Thessalonians 5:22-24).
 - These two scriptures go together.
 - Keep your eyes where they belong. Put on Holy Ghost blinders to avoid temptations.
 - A horse that pulls a wagon has blinders on to keep it focused on the road and so it won't be distracted.
 - If you don't keep your eyes where they belong—repent! Plead the blood and walk in faith.

- II. Plug in with faith for your healing. Make an effort.
 - Brother Kenneth E Hagin had several physical problems including heart problems and paralysis.
 - He believed Mark 11:22-25 and announced that he was healed from the top of his head to the soles of his feet in the mighty Name of Jesus.
 - Brother Hagin made an effort. He swung his paralyzed legs onto the floor.
 - All of a sudden, healing began to come in his legs and in a few minutes, his whole body was totally healed.

- III. It's time for *you* to be healed.
 - Make this confession for healing:
 - “I believe this gospel. I confess Jesus Christ as LORD over my life: spirit, soul and body. I act on The WORD of God. I receive the power of God. Sickness, disease and pain, I resist you in the Name of Jesus. You are not the will of God.



I will not tolerate you in my life. I am saved and healed. The power of sickness is forever broken in my life. Jesus bore my pain. I am forever free. Sin, sickness and fear shall no longer lord it over me. I have been redeemed from the curse of the law. I receive the gospel and act on the gospel. I'm made whole in Jesus' Name."

- Now do what you couldn't do before. Move something you couldn't move before.
- Brother Copeland announced: "I take authority over arthritis, bad eye sight, migraine headaches, low back trouble, inflammation in the joints, sores in the mouth and all kinds of sickness and disease."
- Now take it! Get into action right now!
- Praise The LORD for your healing!

IV. Brother Copeland gave his testimony about his heart.

- In his family, there was a history of heart trouble.
 - The doctor wanted to put a pacemaker that contained a defibrillator into his heart.
 - Brother Copeland was hesitant, but The LORD said to receive the pacemaker and defibrillator by faith.
 - Eventually with faith, prayer and exercise, his heart was so much better, they had to turn off the defibrillator because he didn't need it anymore. He's planning to live to be 120.
- Say this confession: "I take my new heart. I have it now."
- Use the key: Praise God and thank Him for your healing!
